The Production Trial Run requires that the process documentation including Process Flows, PFMEAs, Control Plans and Work Instructions are completed and that the operators are trained. Also, gauging, tooling and the equipment must be made ready. MSA studies and Process Capability studies should all be completed prior to the PPAP. Warranty preparation and submission is also covered.

- PPAP Coordinators / persons who have direct responsibility for preparation, assembly or review of PPAP components or packages
- Auditors and those responsible for supplier PPAP documentation
