Seminar Content

With the release of IATF 16949:2016 this fall, now is the time to prepare. Omnex is offering a one-day transition training course that highlights the intent and content of the key changes from the ISO 9001:2008 revision. There will be class discussion and group exercises to reinforce the key learnings.

This course will not cover clauses of the Standard that did not significantly change. There will be a closed book final exam to confirm participant understanding, but it will not adversely affect receiving credit for attendance.
